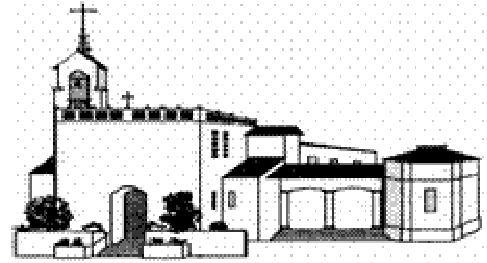

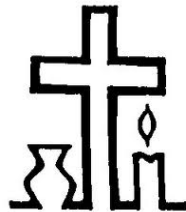


The Diocese of Sacramento celebrates World Day of the Sick
